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This astrological portrait of your child is intended to give you insight into his unique gifts and challenges. Much of a child's behavior which may puzzle or stymie his parents are quite normal, common "developmental stages" of childhood, and there are a number of fine books available on the subject which illuminate the predictable stages that children experience as they unfold. In addition to the universal patterns, each child is an individual with particular qualities, potentials, and needs, and an understanding of these can help you parent your child more wisely and effectively. Acceptance and appreciation for a child's basic nature, and an awareness of the places where there might be stress or difficulties for your child, can be important allies in your parenting.

You will find that the interpretation of your child's chart is written in simple language, uncluttered by astrological jargon. If a statement appears to contradict another statement, then he exhibits these opposite qualities at different times in his life. For example, a statement that he is highly sociable and gregarious and a statement that you prefer solitude seemingly contradict each other; this means that he vacillates, and needs both sociability and solitude at different times.

ASCENDANT

The RISING SIGN in the birthchart (also known as the Ascendant) shows how this child faces life, his basic attitude or stance toward the world, the way he comes across, and how he appears to others.

Leo Rising:

The desire to be unique, to stand out, to be Somebody Special, is very pronounced in Justin. Creating a favorable impression on others is very important to him, and he may seem inordinately concerned with his appearance, having the "right" clothes, and in general presenting a proud face to the world. He radiates a warm, vibrant energy that does make other people notice him. He seems strong, centered, and confident, and he makes a powerful impact on his environment. He may well have a certain dignity or regal bearing that commands respect from others. He likes to do things on a grand, royal scale, and he disdains pettiness. He will be known for his generosity of spirit.

Justin has an inherently creative, colorful, or dramatic manner which simply cannot be ignored. He tends to come across in an exaggerated or theatrical way which can be either funny and appealing, or rather overbearing. He does not very much like to share the spotlight with others, and he is likely to try to blatantly or subtly upstage anyone who is receiving attention. Dress-up games, putting on plays or puppet shows, and similar entertainments are likely to be among his favorite activities. He likes to express himself boldly. He does not just want to read a story; he wants to act it out. He is quite a performer, and he has an exuberant, lively, enthusiastic quality that is likely to last his whole life.

Strong-willed and proud, Justin dislikes taking orders. A pliant, submissive, always-agreeable child he will never be. He needs firm, consistent, and strong discipline at times, but it must be done with some regard for his feelings and his pride. If he ever loses respect for you, it will be next to impossible to have a cooperative, harmonious relationship with him.

Asc. Trine Moon:

Justin is apt to be very well-liked because he seems to instinctively understand people and give them the kinds of strokes and empathy they really want. He helps them feel a sense of safety and belonging and will take them under his wing if need be. At the same time, he thrives in an atmosphere that is personal and emotionally supportive. A small classroom where everyone is on first name basis suits her far better than a more impersonal and competitive one, for instance. Good feelings and "good vibes" are what he is after.

Asc. Opposition Mercury:

Justin is very communicative, needs a lot of conversation, and solicits other people's ideas and opinions on just about everything. He can be argumentative at times, primarily for the purpose of drawing someone into a discussion. Matching his wits or debating with others may well be a favorite pastime.

Asc. Opposition Mars:

Justin sometimes has trouble getting along with others because he is so sure of what he wants and he does not readily compromise or give in when others' needs conflict with his own. He is very competitive, also. It may appear that he actually enjoys fighting, and to some extent, that is probably true. It would be good for him to learn to harness and direct some of his aggressiveness, as in karate or some other form of martial arts.

Asc. Square Uranus:

Justin can be high-strung, erratic, or nervous at times. There is an electric, dynamic quality about him, and he may not be especially reliable. He acts spontaneously, on impulse. He also resists conforming to rules and conventions imposed by others.

Asc. Trine Neptune:

Justin blends into his surroundings and seems to absorb or pick up other people's behavior and emotions, so it is important for him to be in a healthy, positive environment. He has a gentle, yielding quality about him, and he is rather impressionable as a child.

He loves fantasy play and imaginative, whimsical games. He may seem a bit other-worldly at times.

Asc. Sextile Pluto:

Anything hidden, secretive, mysterious, or taboo holds great fascination for Justin, and he questions and probes until he gets answers. He loves to investigate the unknown.

SUN

The SUN in the birthchart represents who this child is at heart, his primary thrust in life, and what path he needs to follow in order to fulfill himself as a unique individual. It indicates who he is inside rather than the way he appears (which is shown more clearly by the Rising Sign).

Sun in Aquarius:

Independent-minded and strong-willed, Justin has his own ideas about how things should be done, and they often do not conform to any already-existing standards or patterns. In fact, he seems to positively delight in challenging custom and convention. Born with a strong need to experiment, he is drawn to the novel and unusual in people, ideas, fashions, and lifestyles. Innovation, originality, inventiveness, and discovering new or alternative ways of doing things are his trademark. Much flexibility, open-mindedness, and tolerance will be required of his parents, for he is likely to overturn all sorts of precedents in his own distinctly individual manner. His development may proceed in an erratic, zigzag sort of way. He will probably develop rapidly in some areas, and lag behind in others, and his timing tends to be somewhat different than the norm, so that comparing him to the "typical" or "average" child in the standard child-care manuals may be confusing or useless.

Justin has little regard for tradition and the authority of the past, and "That's the way it has always been done here" or "You will do it because I'm your Father, and I said so" just are not sufficient explanations for him. He is quite logical and intelligent, and he needs to have a clear reason for everything.

Justin is also quite social, and he shines when he is with other children - the more, the merrier. Inherently idealistic, democratic, and fair, he does not like to discriminate or to exclude anyone, and he may not even have a favorite playmate. ("Everyone is my friend.") He maintains his independence and a certain detachment, even with his best friends. When he is with his buddies, he will often try to organize and coordinate everyone's activities so that each person gets a turn, and also so that everything happens as HE thinks it should. He usually has strong, fixed ideas about things.

Justin lets his head rule rather than his heart, and he needs to be encouraged to feel and empathize more. If he develops an emotional sensitivity towards others, he is likely to become a true humanitarian.

Sun in 6th house:

Conscientiousness and earnestness about doing a good job enable Justin to take on responsibilities at an early age. He enjoys acquiring skills and doing practical and functional things. He likes to be useful. Learning to operate or repair things around the house, to sew or weave or practice some other craft, or to give Mom or Dad a good foot rub will please and satisfy him. He's very interested in health-related matters--partly because his own health tends to be delicate.

Sun Trine Jupiter:

It may seem that life is always on Justin's side, and that Fortune smiles on him more than on most people. Mostly that stems from the fact the he does not worry a lot and he seems always to expect everything to turn out well for him. He is generous and large-spirited, and the world responds to him in kind. The only drawback is that he may not be inclined to push himself, to work hard, or to be very motivated to develop the gifts and opportunities he has.

Sun Trine Saturn:

Sensible and mature from a fairly young age, Justin handles responsibility well and can be relied upon to keep his agreements. He likes having an older, experienced person teach him things, especially practical skills or how to make his way in the adult world. He may seem like a little adult at times, and he does not appreciate being treated "like a child." His dignity and self-respect are precious to him, so do not tease him or make him feel small.

MERCURY

MERCURY represents thinking and reasoning processes, the way your child's mind works, his intellectual inclinations and way of communicating ideas.

Mercury in Pisces:

Justin's mind is intuitive and imaginative rather than strictly logical. More of an artist or poet than a scientist, he daydreams a lot, and it may be hard for him to articulate what he perceives and thinks about. Dry technical subjects hold no appeal for him.

Mercury in 7th house:

This child likes to talk with people and find out how they think, and he'll follow you around the house and "talk your ears off" in an attempt to converse with you. He may be a chatterbox in school too, and the telephone may well be his favorite "toy"!

Mercury Conjunct Mars:

Justin has a sharp wit and a direct, decisive, forceful way of speaking. He defends his ideas and beliefs quite vigorously and often provokes arguments. He always seems to need to have the last word!

Mercury Square Uranus:

Justin has an inventive, creative, original way of thinking and is apt to be suddenly inspired with a new idea or way of understanding a problem. He is likely to come up with unusual solutions to problems, but his mind works in an intuitive, non-linear way, and he cannot always give a logical explanation for his ideas. He is often bored and restless in a conventional, highly predictable, structured learning environment. Hastiness or nervousness can be a problem at times.

MOON

The MOON in the birthchart indicates how he deals with and expresses feelings, how he experiences the world on an emotional, feeling, non-verbal level, what his emotional needs are, and what he needs to feel secure, comfortable and at ease.

Moon in Sagittarius:

Justin has a generous, open friendliness about him, a buoyant optimism and cheerfulness, that is quite appealing. He has a natural self confidence that enables him to take risks and to leap headlong into the unknown with delightful and refreshing abandon. Even if he fails dismally, he is quite resilient, both emotionally and otherwise, and he is even inclined to be philosophical about it all.

Ever eager to explore his world, he heartily dislikes being restricted or held back in any way, and he does not readily understand what "off limits" means. He has a strong sense of adventure and usually responds well to new situations and people, especially if they appear to promise something new and exciting. He is flexible, adapts well to change, and is open to trying new things (like unusual foods) more than most children. (He may, in fact, have some rather sophisticated or exotic tastes.) Unless he is getting sick or there is something really troubling him, he will not be a very clinging, dependent, needy child. In fact, you might wish he needed you more or was more of a cuddler. He has a sort of breezy independence, even at a young age.

Justin is likely to test your authority quite a lot, and though he definitely needs to know that there are firm rules and boundaries, he does not respond well to strong directives or commands. If you (respectfully!) ask him to comply with your wishes, he MIGHT. It is not that he is likely to openly rebel against your rules, but he will good-humoredly ignore them or go around them as much as he can, and no amount of sternness is likely to really change him. He is a very gregarious, sociable child, however, and not allowing him to see a playmate for a certain length of time can be very effective with him. Using humor to coax him out of a recalcitrant mood also works very well with him. He has a great sense of fun.

Moon in 4th house:

Justin will always be extremely attached to home and family, and he may seem to need a lot of emotional sustenance, especially from his mother (or female caregiver). He retreats into his own private space--his bedroom or some other little nook--whenever he feels threatened. Moving this "base of security"--to a new town or even a new home--can be quite upsetting and stressful for him. At such times, he may temporarily regress to somewhat babyish behavior.

Moon Conjunct Neptune:

Justin is impressionable, receptive, and rather passive, and he is highly sensitive to other people's feelings and the overall emotional tone of his surroundings. He likes to daydream and look things up in his imagination. He has a strong affinity for the ocean.

He would rather withdraw than fight when disagreements arise; he avoids emotional confrontations as much as possible.

Moon Sextile Mars:

Justin enjoys rambunctious, rough-and-tumble games, and though he does not usually look for a fight,, he will stand up for himself when he needs to. He has a lot of restless energy and becomes irritable if he is cooped up for too long.

Moon Sextile Pluto:

Justin instinctively understands other people's unspoken, inner feelings and hidden emotions. If you are hiding your feelings or profess to feel something you do not truly feel, he will not be fooled in the least.

Sometimes his desires or requests may seem irrational and he cannot always explain himself in logical terms, but his intuition is usually accurate, and he knows what he needs.

VENUS

VENUS represents the way your child gives and receives affection, makes friends, and socializes. It also indicates artistic or creative inclinations.

Venus in Capricorn:

Justin takes friendship seriously and is careful about showing his affection until he is certain the other person is trustworthy and reliable. You have to win his friendship or prove yourself to him. Once he takes you into his heart, he is a loyal, faithful, true-blue friend.

Venus in 5th house:

If Justin shows any inclination toward art or creative expression, he should be encouraged to develop his gifts in these areas. He also enjoys activities that require style, grace, and beauty, (e.g., figure skating or dancing). He may, however, prefer recreations that are less strenuous.

Venus Square Pluto:

Justin can be insatiable for affection and love, and he makes a lot of demands on his friends and loved ones. His love needs and feelings are very intense. Jealousy, possessiveness, or trying to control others can be problems for him at times. He sometimes acts irrationally when his feelings have been stirred.

Venus Sextile Uranus:

Justin likes people who are spontaneous, creative, and perhaps eccentric or unusual, and he makes friends with many different kinds of people. He is also creatively inspired himself and is likely to have a good sense of rhythm and a feeling for music and dance.

MARS

MARS represents your child's drive, ambition, will, energy level, and ability to assert himself.

Mars in Aquarius:

Justin is unafraid of being different or asserting his independence and his will, and he challenges authority.

His physical energy is somewhat erratic. He is likely to have quick bursts of energy and activity, and then to suddenly stop or "burn out" on a project.

Mars in 6th house:

Justin is a "worker bee" who works hard at the tasks, chores, and plans he sets for himself. He likes to be organized because he feels he can get a lot done that way. He'll want to be gainfully employed at an early age, and he's not averse to working his way up from the bottom.

Mars Square Uranus:

Justin can be disruptive and uncontrollable if he is restricted for too long. Full of energy, daring, and fighting spirit, he rebels against constraints and dull routine. A craving for action and excitement may lead him to do some foolish things, as he acts very spontaneously and without consideration for the long term effects of his impulsive actions. He could have an explosive temper, too. He likes fireworks!

Mars Trine Pluto:

Justin is capable of strenuous effort, and he is likely to be highly ambitious. When he wants something, he is relentless. He wants to pour his abundant energy into something that is important and that influences people or changes the world in some way. He could be a compulsive worker.

Mars Sextile Neptune:

Justin is unwilling to succeed or get to the top at the expense of other people, and he may lack aggressiveness. A desire to help others, or to put his energy into something that contributes to the greater good than simply his own personal benefit, inspires him.

JUPITER

JUPITER in the birth chart reveals the child's future aspirations, and how he seeks to grow and improve himself. It also indicates areas of natural confidence, success, or "luck."

Jupiter in Libra:

Broadminded tolerance and an idealistic concern for fairness, equality, and "everyone getting a chance" are among Justin's character assets. One benefit of this is that he simply gets along with people very well; other people--especially teachers and others in the broader social world--like him and want to help him. He tends to be the peacemaker among his friends, and can be appealed to through his strong sense of fairness and balance. ("You got to ride in the front seat yesterday; it's his turn today.") He's very personable and considerate, and he wants to be treated as a friend, even by older relatives or adults he sees frequently. He seeks to grow through these friendly alliances with other people.

Jupiter in 2nd house:

Money and material advantages matter quite a lot to Justin, and because he will settle for only the finest quality, that's what he'll attain. (Parents may sigh when he insists on designer apparel or the most expensive pair of shoes.) He'll also want to give the most generous presents, even to casual acquaintances who might invite him to their birthday parties.

While generally "lucky" with finances, he may be wasteful or irresponsible with his money as a youngster, because he's sure "there's plenty more where that came from." Teaching him a little discipline along with that faith will be helpful to him in the long run.

Jupiter Conjunct Saturn:

Justin is apt to have a very constructive relationship with his father or, if not, to seek out other fatherly figures to guide and teach him how to make his way in the world. Positive male influences are definitely something he will seek out and find. He feels empowered when he is taught practical skills he will one day need in the adult world, and would enjoy seeing his parents in their work setting. Given encouragement, he would be one of the most conscientious workers around!

SATURN

The position of SATURN in your child's birth chart indicates the areas in which he is especially insecure, about which he is most serious, and/or in which he works hardest or is hardest on himself. It also reveals those weaknesses which, through effort, may become his greatest strengths.

Saturn in Libra:

Because Justin often feels that even insignificant choices and decisions are heavy matters, he can have difficulty making decisions. He gets caught up in sifting, weighing, balancing, and comparing. Pressing him to reach a conclusion before he had time to consider the various options distresses him, so on minor matters it may be easiest for parents to decide what's best.

Justin also frequently feels that caring for other people is a big responsibility. If he's given the task of caring for a younger sibling or doing some errand or household job for a parent, he'll try his best, but he won't enjoy it much. The responsibility will weigh on him, though he may not say so. He takes arguments between other people quite seriously, and he won't readily forgive a broken promise--even if it was given on the most tentative basis. He has very strict inner rules about how people "should" behave toward one another, and if a friend disappoints him, he may withdraw from the relationship. In fact, he'll sometimes feel that other people are just too much trouble. He may seesaw between feeling lonely and wanting to be left alone.

On the positive side, he has a strong, impartial sense of fairness, and great dedication to fulfilling commitments and obligations toward others. On the negative side, he'll sometimes feel misunderstood, disappointed, and burdened by the need to cooperate with other people.

Saturn in 2nd house:

Justin often worries that there won't always be enough of what he needs. Due to this fear of lack or deprivation, he may be unwilling to freely share his possessions. This child would rather save his allowance than waste it on frivolity or fluff. If he's feeling insecure in any way, he's apt to hoard things--material objects, money--and to become stingy.

MOON'S NODES

The Lunar Nodes are points formed by the moon's orbit around the Earth intersecting with the Earth's path around the Sun. These sensitive "power points" in our child's chart give vital information about those areas of life experience that he will instinctively be drawn to in order to fulfill his life purposes, as well as qualities he needs to develop and express in order to do so. They show where he can be most successful as he unfolds his natural talent

North Node in 12th House in Leo:

Justin's natural way is to do his best work behind the scenes or in seclusion. He needs time to prepare himself and to contact his muse, periods of solitude or minimal social contact, to tap deep wells of creativity, strength, or inner healing. Parents and other people in his life should respect his need for privacy, "down time", and seeming idleness. Sometimes he may feel that he's being neglected, overlooked, or not given credit for his contributions. He may need special support and encouragement from time to time. He is also drawn to the spiritual dimension of life and may find his greatest satisfaction in that path.

The qualities Justin needs in order to succeed in this endeavor are belief in himself and the willingness to following his own heart, rather than concerning himself with what his peers want or think about him. A healthy dose of "selfishness" is in his own, and ultimately everyone else's, best interests.

GENERATIONAL INFLUENCES

The slow-moving planets Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto represent the ideals, changes, and impulses of an entire generation. While the descriptions below may or may not describe your child as an individual, they will tell you about the climate of the times and the underlying issues and challenges of your child's age group.

For instance, when Neptune (which represents one's spiritual ideals, dreams, aspirations, fantasies and illusions) passed through the egalitarian and harmony-loving sign of Libra (from 1943-1957), the children who would grow into the "flower children," hippies, and supporters of the peace movement were born. Not every person born during that time became a hippie or identified themselves with the peace movement, but certainly they were affected by the feeling-tone and ideals of their age group and the times they grew up in. Thus, the following information is intended to give you insight into the important motifs and issues of your child's generation.

URANUS indicates where the impulse for change, innovation, liberation from the past, and experimentation with new forms is the strongest. It is where the status quo is disrupted or uprooted to make way for something new. Sudden inspiration and invention are also represented by Uranus.

Uranus in Scorpio:

Those in this age group (1974-1981) challenge and break through barriers and taboos regarding death, sex, and other very intimate and emotionally-charged issues. There will be extremists and fanatics among them, as they try to bring about changes in these areas. They also deal with their own difficult and tumultuous emotions, which may be reflected in a taste for bizarre art forms, music, etc.

Uranus in 4th house:

Justin's nonconformity and eccentricity may not show on the surface but comes out in private especially at home. Kooky, eclectic decor or an attraction to unorthodox lifestyle is likely. Hi home life may be chaotic, or he may live in many locales during his life, because he is learning how to be free in his soul and too much familiarity and safety doesn't challenge him.

NEPTUNE represents the quest for the ideal, the dream, for something more sublime. The sign it is passing through at the time of one's birth colors one's spiritual aspirations and ideals, and also indicates where the desire to escape reality, to fantasize, deceive oneself, and become lost in illusion is the strongest.

Neptune in Sagittarius:

Tremendous idealism, far-reaching vision, and a wide-open, expanded outlook on life characterize this age group (1970-1984). They believe that anything is possible and often overlook the immediate, obvious, and practical realities of a situation in their quest for something grander, freer, or more encompassing. Ungrounded speculation, airy fantasy, and the tendency to idealize whatever is foreign, faraway, or unattainable are the pitfalls of this age group. However, since their minds are not prematurely set and closed to new possibilities, they are likely to discover truths that more earth-bound minds would never see.

Neptune in 4th house:

Justin has a very dreamy, sensitive, and private side and he needs a tranquil place to retreat to from time to time. He would love to live in a beautiful natural setting, perhaps near water, and if his home is not nurturing and serene he will conjure such a place in his imagination. Home as sanctuary is very important to this child.

Neptune Sextile Pluto:

Those born during this generation have the opportunity to advance spirituality and a consciousness of unity, universality, and brother/sisterhood. Only a few individuals may heed the call, but many will be influenced by them.

PLUTO in the birth chart indicates a process of deep change, transformation, and renewal, often through destruction or confrontation with darkness. This is a process that takes place in society as well as in individuals. Pluto's position in the birth chart shows where one is compulsive, extreme, or learning key life lessons.

Pluto in Libra:

Marriage and/or personal relationships tend to be obsessions with those in this age group (born 1971-1984), and equality, justice, and fair treatment in those relationships are passionate concerns. An awareness of the inevitability and need for continual change within a relationship may make them cautious about making permanent commitments. However, the need to experience deep connectedness and relatedness also compels them. Overcoming dependencies, fears, and resistances to deep sharing are major challenges for them.

Pluto in 3rd house:

Justin has a probing mind and he loves to delve into complex, difficult, or deep subjects. He could be an excellent student but he's apt to have one-sided or narrowly focused interests, to pursue them obsessively, and to neglect other areas. His tendency to ask intensely personal questions or to "grill" you even in a casual conversation may put people off at times, (what was charming and amusing at four is much less so at fourteen). Relationships with siblings may be thorny also. Parents or other caregivers should be alert to any potential abuses or toxic dynamics between Justin and his brothers and/or sisters.
